CHAPTER 312, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to renumber and amend 70.11 (12); and to create 70.11 (12) (b) of the statutes, relating to tax exemption of property belonging to certain organizations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 70.11 (12) of the statutes is renumbered 70.11 (12) (a) and amended to read:

70.11 (12) (a) Property owned by <u>units which are organized in</u> this state of the following organizations: the Boy Scouts of America, units of the Boys' Clubs of America organized in Wisconsin, the Girl Scouts or Camp Fire Girls or by any person as trustee for them which is of property used for the purposes of those organizations, provided no pecuniary profit results to any individual owner or member.

SECTION 2. 70.11 (12) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

70.11 (12) (b) Real property not exceeding 40 acres and the personal property located thereon owned by units which are not organized in this state of the organizations listed in par. (a). No such unit which is not organized in this state may claim an exemption for more than a total of 80 rods of shoreline on lakes, rivers and streams.
