CHAPTER 331, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to amend 176.42 of the statutes, relating to limiting to one quart the size of container in which intoxicating liquors may be sold.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

176.42 of the statutes is amended to read:

176.42 SECRETARY TO PRESCRIBE STANDARDS OF CONTAINERS. The secretary of revenue may by rule prescribe the standard size, form or character of bottles, kegs, barrels, packages or other containers in which intoxicating liquor shall be sold in this state, but shall not set the size of containers in which intoxicating liquor may be sold at a capacity greater than 32 fluid ounces.
