CHAPTER 36, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to amend 56.19 (1) of the statutes, relating to prison labor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

56.19 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

56.19 (1) The superintendent of said house shall place all inmates at such employments, and shall cause all inmates who are minors to be instructed in such branches of useful knowledge, as shall be prescribed by the county board, but no goods manufactured therein shall be offered for sale or sold in the open market, except creative art, literary, musical, handicraft or hobby craft products produced by a prisoner during his leisure.
