CHAPTER 87, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to create 49.54 of the statutes, relating to excluding certain social security benefits from income in determination of aid levels.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

49.54 of the statutes is created to read:

49.54 EXCLUSIONS FROM INCOME FOR AID DETERMINATION.
In determining the income of any needy person who is blind and the amount of aid to be granted such person under s. 49.18; the income of, the budget for the family of and the amount of aid to be granted a person applying for aid to dependent children under s. 49.19; the income and resources of, the budget for and the amount of assistance to be granted a person applying for old-age assistance under ss. 49.20 to 49.37 and 49.41; and the income and resources of, the budget for and the amount of aid to be granted to a totally and permanently disabled person under s. 49.61; the amounts of social security payments received by or for any such person by reason of increases in social security payments provided by amendments to or changes in the federal social security laws taking effect in January 1970 or thereafter shall be disregarded and not considered or taken into account to the extent that federal regulations allow.
