CHAPTER 15, Laws of 1973

- AN ACT to amend 119.30 (1) of the statutes, relating to the establishment of trade schools.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

119.30 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

119.30 (1) The board may establish, conduct and maintain one or more schools for the purpose of giving practical instruction in the useful trades and may purchase the proper machinery, tools and equipment and employ a sufficient number of teachers
