CHAPTER 175, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 349.10 (1) (c); and to create 349.10 (1) (f) of the statutes, relating to authority to prohibit U-turns.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 349.10 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

349.10 (1) (c) Where traffic conditions warrant By order, ordinance or resolution and by the erection of appropriate signs, prohibit right or left turns at intersections or prohibit U-turns by all vehicles or by certain types of vehicles.

SECTION 2. 349.10 (1) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

349.10 (1) (f) By order, ordinance or resolution and by the erection of appropriate signs, prohibit U-turns at specified locations. The local authority with the

approval of the highway commission may prohibit U-turns and erect appropriate signs on state trunk highways within cities and villages.
