CHAPTER 176, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 343.16 (1) (c) of the statutes, relating to issuance of motorcycle licenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

343.16 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.16 (1) (c) The division shall examine every applicant for a license to operate a motor-driven cycle. The division shall waive the examination and validate operation of a motor-driven cycle when the applicant can show to the satisfaction of the division that he has regularly operated a motor-driven cycle for a period of at least one year either as the owner or full-time operator of such vehicle. The division may set standards of past operation to qualify the waiver of examination; such standards shall include make, description, speed, cubic centimeters, piston displacement, miles driven or other pertinent facts.
