**CHAPTER 195, Laws of 1973**

**AN ACT to create 94.41 (1) (k) of the statutes, requiring certification of certain seed.**

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

94.41 (1) (k) of the statutes is created to read:

94.41 (1) (k) Not certified by an official seed certifying agency, if labeled under the variety name of a variety of seed which is protected by and can only be sold as a class of certified seed under a certificate of plant variety protection issued under the federal plant variety protection act (7 U.S.C. 2321 et. seq.), provided that seed from a certified lot may be labeled as to variety name when used in a mixture by, or with the approval of, the owner of the variety.
