CHAPTER 220, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to create 15.377 (4) of the statutes, relating to creating a council on Indian education.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

15.377 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

15.377 (4) COUNCIL ON INDIAN EDUCATION. There is created a council on Indian education attached to the department of public instruction for administrative purposes. The council shall consist of 10 persons who are members of the education committee of the great lakes intertribal council, and shall be appointed by the governor. The council shall advise the state superintendent of public instruction, the board of regents of the

university of Wisconsin system, the higher educational aids board, and the board of vocational, technical and adult education.
