CHAPTER 241, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 114.33 (1) of the statutes, relating to initiation and sponsorship of airport navigational aids by the department of transportation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 114.33 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

114.33 (1) Any county, city, village or town, either singly or jointly with one or more counties, cities, villages or towns, desiring to sponsor an airport development project to be constructed with federal aid and state aid or with the state aid alone as provided by this chapter, may initiate such project in the manner provided by this section. Any state agency The department may initiate and sponsor an airport project in the same manner as a local governing body. The department may install, operate and maintain air navigation facilities with or without federal aid and may enter into agreements with sponsors to share the maintenance and operation costs of such facilities.

SECTION 2. Change of cross reference. Unless the 1973 legislature restructures the appropriation to the department of transportation as shown by proposed section 20.395 (4) (v) in the executive budget act, the reference in section 20.395 (1) (m) of the statutes to "s. 114.32" is expanded to read "s. 114.32 or 114.33".
