CHAPTER 257, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to renumber 253.02 (1) (c) 35; and to amend 252.015 (1) (b), 253.02 (1) (m) (intro.) and 253.18 (2) of the statutes, relating to increasing judgeships in Milwaukee and Waukesha counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 252.015 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

252.015 (1) (b) Second circuit, 48 19 branches.

SECTION 2. 253.02 (1) (c) 35 of the statutes is renumbered 253.02 (1) (d) 35.

SECTION 3. 253.02 (1) (m) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

253.02 (1) (m) (intro.) Thirteen Fourteen branches:

SECTION 4. 253.18 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

253.18 (2) In counties having a population of 500,000 or more, branches 1 and 2 shall be the probate branches, branch 3 shall be the traffic court branch. Branch 4 shall be the misdemeanor court branch. Branch 12 shall be the traffic-misdemeanor court branch and shall in addition to all jurisdiction otherwise prescribed or conferred by ss. 253.11 (2) and 253.12 have such jurisdiction as set forth in s. 48.17. Branches 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and, 13 and 14 shall be the civil court branches. The revenue from all actions for the violation of ordinances of a city of the 1st class, in any such county, brought in the county court shall be paid to the city monthly as provided in s. 288.10. Said city of the 1st class shall have access to all books and records concerned with accounting of revenues and expenditures relating to this chapter.

SECTION 5. Election and terms. Judges to hold the offices created under this act shall be elected at the spring election of 1975 to serve terms commencing July 1, 1975, and ending the first Monday in January 1981.
