CHAPTER 44, Laws of 1973

- AN ACT to create 975.06 (6) of the statutes, relating to placement of persons convicted of sex crimes at sex crimes facilities and allowing credit for time served at such facilities.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

975.06 (6) of the statutes is created to read:

975.06 (6) Persons committed under this section who are also encumbered with other sentences, whether concurrent with or consecutive to the commitment, shall be received or remain at the sex crimes facility designated by the department. Such facilities may be regarded as state prisons for the purpose of beginning the other sentences, crediting time served on them, and computing parole eligibility dates.
