**CHAPTER 1, Laws of 1975**

AN ACT to create 108.141 (9) of the statutes, relating to unemployment compensation extended benefit indicator modifications.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

108.141 (9) of the statutes is created to read:

108.141 (9) INDICATOR MODIFICATIONS. (a) A Wisconsin "on" or "off" indicator shall be determined without regard to sub. (1) (d) 1 or (e) 1 for any period that waiver of such provisions is authorized under s. 203 (e) of Title II of P.L. 91-373 and any amendments thereto on the effective date of this act (1975) or thereafter.

(b) A national "on" or "off" indicator under sub. (1) (b) and (c) shall be determined as though the 4.5% figure contained in such paragraphs were changed to 4.0% for any period that such change is authorized under s. 203 (d) of Title II of P.L. 91-373 and any amendments thereto on the effective date of this act (1975) or thereafter.
