

CHAPTER 116, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 59.03 (3) (c) of the statutes, relating to apportionment of county supervisory districts due to changes in municipal boundaries.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.03 (3) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.03 (3) (c) *Changes during decade.* ~~New ward lines adopted after~~ After the enactment of a plan of supervisory districts under par. (b) ~~due to, a municipal~~ incorporation, annexation, detachment or consolidation may serve as a basis for altering between federal decennial censuses the boundaries of supervisory districts ~~which utilized such ward lines as district boundaries,~~ in the discretion of the county board. The number of supervisory districts in the county shall not be changed by any action under this paragraph. Any plan of county supervisory districts enacted under par. (b) may be amended under this paragraph but shall remain in effect as amended until superseded by another plan enacted by the county board under said paragraph and filed with the elections board.
