

**CHAPTER 193, Laws of 1975**

AN ACT to amend 858.13 of the statutes, relating to the number of appraisers required for inventory of decedent's estate.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

858.13 of the statutes is amended to read:

**858.13 When appraisal necessary.** Except as provided in s. 858.15 all inventoried property shall be appraised by one or more disinterested persons appointed by the court. The appraiser or appraisers shall appraise each item in the inventory which is required to be appraised and certify to its value. Where the estate is situated in 2 or more counties, an appraiser or appraisers may be appointed for each county.
