CHAPTER 215, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 13.52 (1) (intro.) and (a) of the statutes, relating to the number of legislators on the joint survey committee on tax exemptions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

13.52 (1) (intro.) and (a) of the statutes are amended to read:

13.52 (1) (intro.) CREATION. There is created a joint survey committee on tax exemptions composed of ~~7~~ 9 members, as follows:

(a) Two ~~senators~~ members of the most populous political party and one member of the next most populous political party in the senate and ~~2 representatives to the members of the most populous political party and one member of the next most populous political party in the assembly,~~ selected as are standing committee members of the respective houses;
