CHAPTER 216, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to create 29.145 (3) of the statutes, relating to providing a daily sports fishing license for residents.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.145 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

29.145 (3) As an alternative to the requirements of this section, any resident 16 years of age or older shall have the right to take, catch or kill fish, or fish with hook

and line or with rod and reel in the waters of the Great Lakes and Green Bay if a daily sports fishing license has been issued in accordance with procedures established by the department. The fee for each such license shall be \$2 and shall be effective only for the date of issuance. A 25-cent fee as compensation for issuing such licenses through agents shall be paid.
