CHAPTER 298, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 146.085 of the statutes, relating to a penalty for charging an admission for using toilets.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

146.085 of the statutes is amended to read:

146.085 Pay toilets prohibited. ~~If the (1) PROHIBITION. The owner or manager of any public building, other than licensed hotels and resorts, as defined in s. 101.01 (2) (h), shall keep more than 50% of the toilet compartments of any public toilet room locked, he shall not permit an admission fee to be charged for the use of any toilet compartment.~~

(2) PENALTY. Any person who violates this section shall be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$50. It shall be the duty of the

(3) ENFORCEMENT. The department, the department of industry, labor and human relations and the public service commission ~~to~~ shall enforce this section within their respective jurisdictions.
