CHAPTER 315, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 176.08 of the statutes, relating to beer sales in municipal liquor stores.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

176.08 of the statutes is amended to read:

176.08 Municipal stores prohibited. No city, village or town may engage in the sale of intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages, except as authorized under s. 66.054 (8) (b). This section shall not apply to municipal liquor stores in operation on November 6, 1969. Such stores may engage in the sale of intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages or both.
