AN ACT to repeal 39.45; and to create 36.25 (16) of the statutes, relating to authorizing the board of regents of the university of Wisconsin system to establish and maintain a school of veterinary medicine and satellite food animal clinical facility ~~and increasing appropriations.~~

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 36.25 (16) of the statutes is created to read:

36.25 (16) SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE AND SATELLITE FOOD ANIMAL CLINICAL FACILITY. The board may establish and maintain a school of veterinary medicine at the university of Wisconsin-Madison and a satellite food animal clinical facility at the university of Wisconsin-River Falls. Existing facilities at those institutions shall be used to the maximum possible extent for auxiliary instructional and research support of the veterinary and satellite food animal clinical programs.

SECTION 2. 39.45 of the statutes is repealed.

~~SECTION 3. Building commission, advance planning and appropriation increase. The state building commission shall release sufficient advance planning funds for the development of a school of veterinary medicine and satellite food animal clinical facility authorized under section 36.25 (16) of the statutes, as created by this act.~~

~~SECTION 4. University of Wisconsin system appropriation increase. The appropriation in section 20.285 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the laws of 1975, is increased by \$238,600 in fiscal year 1976-77 for the purposes of establishing and maintaining a school of veterinary medicine and satellite food animal clinical facility under section 36.25 (16) of the statutes, as created by this act.~~

SECTION 5. University of Wisconsin school of veterinary medicine fiscal support study. The department of revenue shall conduct a study of potential sources of fiscal support for a school of veterinary medicine as authorized under section 36.25 (16) of the statutes, as created by this act. The findings of the study shall be reported to the governor and the legislature by January 3, 1977.
