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CHAPTER 54, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to create 625.35 of the statutes, relating to annual reports by health professional liability insurers to the commissioner of insurance and granting rule-making authority.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

625.35 of the statutes is created to read:

625.35 Reports by health professional liability insurers. Each insurer doing business in this state in health professional liability insurance shall report the following information to the commissioner on or before March 1 of each year for the previous calendar year:

- (1) The total number of insureds within each rating class.
 - (2) The total amount of premiums paid by the insureds in each rating class.
 - (3) The total number of claims, as defined by the commissioner by rule, filed against insureds in each rating class, the year in which the incident giving rise to each claim occurred, and the total number of claims outstanding as of December 31.
 - (4) The total number and amount of claims paid by the insurer for insureds in each rating class, the year in which the incident giving rise to each claim occurred, and the costs as defined by the commissioner by rule, to the insurer relating to investigation, processing and defense of such claims that can be identified with such claims.
 - (5) The number of lawsuits filed against the insurer's insureds.
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
