

CHAPTER 66, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 348.25 (4); and to create 348.25 (4) (b) of the statutes, relating to permits for oversize motor vehicles transporting implements of husbandry.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 348.25 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

348.25 (4) Except as provided under s. 348.27 (7m), permits shall be issued only for the transporting of a single article or vehicle which exceeds statutory size, weight or load limitations and which cannot reasonably be divided or reduced to comply with statutory size, weight or load limitations, except that a:

(a) A permit may be issued for the transportation of property consisting of more than one article, some or all of which exceeds statutory size limitations, provided statutory gross weight limitations are not thereby exceeded and provided the additional articles transported do not cause the vehicle and load to exceed statutory size limitations in any way in which such limitations would not be exceeded by the single article.

SECTION 2. 348.25 (4) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

348.25 (4) (b) A single trip permit may be issued for the transportation of a load of implements of husbandry, consisting of not more than 2 articles, when the load does not exceed the length requirement in s. 348.07 by more than 5 feet.
