CHAPTER 255, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 943.20 (3) (d) (intro.) and 4; and to create 943.20 (3) (d) 5 of the statutes, relating to making theft of a firearm a felony.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 943.20 (3) (d) (intro.) and 4 of the statutes are amended to read:

943.20 (3) (d) (intro.) If the value of the property is ~~less than~~ does not exceed \$2,500 and any of the following circumstances exist, a fine of not more than \$5,000 or imprisonment for not more than 5 years or both:

4. The property is taken after physical disaster, riot, bombing, or the proximity of battle has necessitated its removal from a building; or

SECTION 2. 943.20 (3) (d) 5 of the statutes is created to read:

943.20 (3) (d) 5. The property is a firearm.
