## CHAPTER 256, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 17.245 of the statutes, relating to temporary appointments to fill new local elected offices.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 17.245 of the statutes is amended to read:

**17.245 New city, village or town office, temporary appointment.** Whenever an elective office is created in a city, village or town pursuant to law or ordinance, ~~a temporary appointment may be made by the governing body pending the election of the incumbent for the first full term~~ the office shall not be deemed vacant until it has first been filled by the electorate.
