## CHAPTER 266, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to repeal 57.07; and to amend 53.11 (7) (b) of the statutes, relating to paroles for female inmates of the state prisons.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 53.11 (7) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

53.11 (7) (b) Any person on parole under this subsection may be returned to prison as provided in s. 57.06 (3) ~~or s. 57.07 (2)~~ to serve the remainder of his a sentence. ~~He~~ The person may earn good time on the balance of ~~such~~ the sentence while so in prison, subject to forfeiture thereof for misconduct as ~~herein~~ provided in this section. Subject to the approval of the department, ~~he~~ the person may again be released on parole thereafter under either this section or s. 57.06 ~~or s. 57.07~~, whichever is applicable. The remainder of ~~his~~ the sentence shall be deemed to be the amount by which ~~his~~ the original sentence was reduced by good time.

SECTION 2. 57.07 of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. **Applicability.** This act shall apply to sentences imposed for acts committed on or after the effective date of this act.
