CHAPTER 267, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 865.16 (1) (intro.) of the statutes, relating to closing estates by sworn statement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 865.16 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

865.16 (1) (intro.) As an alternative to closing an estate under ch. 863, a personal representative may close an estate by filing with the ~~court~~ probate registrar a verified statement that the personal representative, or a prior personal representative whom he or she has succeeded, has:
