CHAPTER 286, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to renumber 111.32 (5) (g) 4; and to create 108.04 (7) (i) and 111.32 (5) (g) 4 of the statutes, relating to prohibiting sexual harassment in employment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 108.04 (7) (i) of the statutes is created to read:

108.04 (7) (i) Paragraph (a) shall not apply if the department determines that the employe terminated because the employer made employment, compensation, promotion or job assignments contingent upon the employe's consent to sexual contact or sexual intercourse as defined in s. 940.225 (5).

SECTION 2. 111.32 (5) (g) 4 of the statutes is renumbered 111.32 (5) (g) 5.

SECTION 3. 111.32 (5) (g) 4 of the statutes is created to read:

111.32 (5) (g) 4. For any employer, labor organization, licensing agency or person to make hiring, employment, admission, licensure, compensation, promotion or job assignments contingent upon a person's consent to sexual contact or sexual intercourse as defined in s. 940.225 (5).
