CHAPTER 333, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to repeal 456.04 (4); to renumber and amend 456.04 (5) and to amend 456.04 (1) to (3) of the statutes, relating to repealing the requirement that nursing home administrators have 2 years of college level study.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 456.04 (1), as affected by chapter 29, laws of 1977, (2) and (3) of the statutes are amended to read:

456.04 (1) Pays the fee under s. 440.05 (1); ~~and,~~

(2) Submits satisfactory evidence of good moral character and suitability; ~~and,~~

(3) Is 18 years of age; ~~and,~~

SECTION 2. 456.04 (4) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 456.04 (5) of the statutes is renumbered 456.04 (4) and amended to read:

456.04 (4) ~~After July 1, 1972, any~~ If the person who has not completed a regular course of study which the examining board considers as adequate academic preparation for nursing home administration ~~in addition to that required under sub. (4) shall submit,~~ submits evidence satisfactory to the examining board that ~~he~~ the person has attended specialized courses or a program of study in the area of nursing home administration.
