CHAPTER 395, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 30.71 of the statutes, relating to boats equipped with toilets, granting rule-making authority and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 30.71 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

30.71 Boats equipped with toilets. No person may, while maintaining or operating any boat equipped with toilets on inland waters or outlying waters of this state, as defined in s. 29.01 (4), dispose of any toilet wastes in any manner into the inland or outlying waters of this state. The department of health and social services may adopt rules necessary to carry out the purposes of this section.

SECTION 2. **Program citation.** In the list of program responsibility citations for the department of health and social services under section 15.191 (intro.) of the statutes, delete reference to section "30.71 (1)" and insert reference to section "30.71".
