CHAPTER 442, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to renumber and amend 111.70 (3) (d) of the statutes, relating to collective bargaining units consisting of police supervisors in cities of the 1st class and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 111.70 (3) (d) of the statutes is renumbered 111.70 (8) and amended to read:

111.70 (8) (title) SUPERVISORY UNITS. ~~Nothing in this~~ This subchapter shall does not preclude law enforcement or fire-fighting fire fighting supervisors from organizing in separate units of supervisors for purposes of negotiating with their municipal employers. The commission shall by rule establish procedures for certification of such units of supervisors and the levels of supervisors to be included in the units. The commission may require that the representative in a supervisory unit shall be an organization that is a separate local entity from the representative of the nonsupervisory municipal employes, but such requirement ~~shall does~~ not prevent affiliation by a supervisory representative with the same parent state or national organization as the nonsupervisory municipal employe representative. In cities of the 1st class, this section applies to law enforcement supervisors. For such purposes, the term "municipal employe" includes law enforcement supervisors in cities of the 1st class.
