CHAPTER 48, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 20.445 (5) (a) (title) and 102.475 (title) and (8) (c) of the statutes, relating to special compensation for the death of a member of a rescue squad who is killed in the line of duty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.445 (5) (a) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.445 (5) (a) (title) *Benefits for law enforcement, correctional officers, firemen and rescue squad members.*

SECTION 2. 102.475 (title) and (8) (c) of the statutes are amended to read:

102.475 (title) Death benefit; law enforcement and correctional officers, firemen and rescue squad members.

(8) (c) "Fireman" means any person employed by the state or any political subdivision as a member or officer of a fire department or a member of a volunteer department, including the state fire marshal and deputies, or a member of a legally organized rescue squad.
