CHAPTER 200, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 9.01 (1) (b) (intro.) of the statutes, relating to the time for commencing ballot recounts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 9.01 (1) (b) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

9.01 (1) (b) (intro.) The proper board of canvassers shall reconvene at 9 a.m. on the day following the <u>last day for</u> filing of a petition and proceed to recount the ballots in all wards specified and otherwise check the fact allegations of the petition <u>or petitions</u>. The recount shall proceed for each ward as follows:
