CHAPTER 226, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 343.50 (2) of the statutes, relating to the age for application for an identification card.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 343.50 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

CHAPTER 226

343.50 (2) WHO MAY APPLY. Any ~~adult~~ resident of this state who is at least 16 years of age and who does not possess a valid operator's license issued under this chapter may apply to the department for an identification card pursuant to this section. The card is not a license for purposes of this chapter and is to be used for identification purposes only.
