

CHAPTER 236, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to create 341.14 (6) of the statutes, relating to special license plates for former prisoners of war.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 341.14 (6) of the statutes is created to read:

341.14 (6) Upon application to register an automobile or station wagon by any person who was a member of any of the U.S. armed services and who was held as a prisoner of war during any of the conflicts described in s. 45.35 (5) (b) to (g), and upon submission of a statement from the U.S. veterans administration certifying that the person was a prisoner of war during one of the conflicts described in s. 45.35 (5) (b) to (g), the department shall issue to the person a special plate which is colored red, white and blue and which has the words "ex-prisoner of war" placed on the plate in the manner designated by the department. An additional fee of \$10 shall be charged for the issuance of the plates. Registration plates issued under this subsection shall expire annually on August 31.

SECTION 2. **Effective date.** This act takes effect on the first day of the 6th month commencing after its publication.
