

CHAPTER 244, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 121.05 (1) (a) 3 and 121.78 (1) of the statutes, relating to state aid for tuition payments by school districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 121.05 (1) (a) 3 of the statutes is amended to read:

121.05 (1) (a) 3. Pupils who are residents of one school district who are enrolled in another school district and for whom tuition is paid under s. 115.87 (5) or 121.78 ~~(2)~~ or ~~(3)~~; and

SECTION 2. 121.78 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

121.78 (1) Upon the approval of the state superintendent, the school board of the district of residence and the school board of the district of attendance may make a written agreement to permit an elementary or high school pupil to attend a public school, including an out-of-state school, outside the school district of residence, and the school district of residence shall pay the tuition. The school district of residence shall be paid state aid as though the pupil were enrolled in the school district of residence.

SECTION 4. **Effective date.** This act takes effect on July 1, 1980, applicable for school year 1980-81 and thereafter.
