CHAPTER 116, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to repeal 8.17 (2) (a) to (c); and to renumber and amend 8.17 (2) (intro.) of the statutes, relating to the number of signatures required on nomination papers for party committeeman or committeewoman.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 8.17 (2) (intro.) of the statutes is renumbered 8.17 (2) and amended to read:

8.17 (2) Nomination papers shall be in substantially the same form as those required under s. 8.15. Nomination papers shall be circulated no sooner than June 1 preceding the election and shall be filed in the office of the county clerk or board of election commissioners not later than 5 p.m. on the 2nd Tuesday of July in those years when a September primary is held. The number of required signatures shall be: of not less than 20 nor more than 40 electors are required.

SECTION 2. 8.17 (2) (a) to (c) of the statutes are repealed.
