CHAPTER 343, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to renumber and amend 27.01 (2r) (d); and to create 27.01 (2v) (e) of the statutes, relating to campground reservation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 27.01 (2r) (d) of the statutes is renumbered 27.01 (2v) and amended to read:

27.01 (2v) (title) CAMPGROUND RESERVATION SYSTEM. (a) (title) Authorization. The department may establish a campground reservation system at any of the state parks or state forest campgrounds and may participate with owners of private campgrounds in a cooperative reservation system.

(b) (title) Exclusion of 25% of sites. Twenty-five percent of the total number of sites at every campground under a reservation system shall be excluded from reservation, for the benefit of the traveling public.

(c) (title) Reservation fee. A reservation fee sufficient to equal the estimated cost of administering the system shall be charged.

(d) (title) Reservation applications. The department may accept reservation applications and give reservations from residents for each year beginning on January 1 of each that year. The department may accept reservation applications from nonresidents for each year beginning on February 1 of that year. All reservations reservation applications received by the department which are postmarked prior to the earliest date upon which reservations may be accepted are invalid and shall be returned, or otherwise disregarded. **Reservations** Reservation applications may be made in person.

SECTION 2. 27.01 (2v) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

27.01 (2v) (e) *Priorities.* The department shall give reservations for each year beginning on January 1 in the order in which valid reservation applications are received until the available reservation sites in a campground for a given date are exhausted.
