

1983 Wisconsin Act 109

AN ACT to renumber 15.111; to renumber and amend 15.11; and to create 15.195 (4) (a) to (f) of the statutes, relating to members of the child abuse and neglect prevention board.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 15.11 of the statutes, as created by 1983 Wisconsin Act 27, is renumbered 15.195 (4) and amended to read:

15.195 (4) CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT PREVENTION BOARD. There is created a child abuse and neglect prevention board which is attached to the department of health and social services. ~~Members appointed by the governor under s. 15.03.~~ The board shall consist of 14 members as follows:

(g) Eight public members appointed by the governor for staggered 3-year terms. Six of the public members shall be appointed on the basis of expertise, experience and interest in the prevention of child abuse and neglect or expertise and experience in intervention in cases of child abuse and neglect. One public member shall be an adult who was a victim of abuse or neglect as a child. One public member shall be a parent who formerly abused or neglected one or more of his or her children and who has received treatment or advice from an organization that provides child abuse and neglect prevention and intervention services.

SECTION 2. 15.111 of the statutes, as created by 1983 Wisconsin Act 27, is renumbered 15.191 (4).

SECTION 3. 15.195 (4) (a) to (f) of the statutes are created to read:

15.195 (4) (a) The governor or his or her designee.

(b) The attorney general or his or her designee.

(c) The secretary of health and social services or his or her designee.

(d) The state superintendent of public instruction or his or her designee.

(e) One representative to the assembly appointed by the speaker of the assembly.

(f) One senator appointed by the president of the senate.

SECTION 4. **Nonstatutory provisions; appointment of initial members of the child abuse and neglect prevention board.** Members of the child abuse and neglect prevention board appointed under section 15.11 of the statutes, as created by 1983 Wisconsin Act 27, shall, on the effective date of this act, continue to serve as members of the child abuse and neglect prevention board under section 15.195 (4) of the statutes, as affected by this act, except that no more than 8 public members may serve on the board. If the governor has appointed more than 8 public members to the board under section 15.11 of the statutes, as created by 1983 Wisconsin Act 27, the governor shall designate which 8 shall continue to serve on the board under section 15.195 (4) of the statutes, as affected by this act. The governor shall also designate the term of each public member of the board, so that 3 terms shall expire on May 1, 1984, 3 terms shall expire on May 1, 1985, and 2 terms shall expire on May 1, 1986. Thereafter, the public members of the board shall be appointed as provided under section 15.195 (4) (g) of the statutes.
