### 1983 Wisconsin Act 337

AN ACT to amend 108.04 (12) (e) and 108.06 (4) (b) (intro.) of the statutes, relating to qualification for unemployment compensation benefits by individuals receiving benefits under the federal longshoreman's and harbor workers' compensation act or similar federal programs.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 108.04 (12) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

108.04 (12) (e) Any individual who receives a temporary total disability payment under ch. 102 or the federal longshoreman's and harbor workers' compensation act (33 USC 901 to 950) or a similar federal program unless precluded by federal law for a whole week shall be ineligible for benefits paid or payable for that same week under this chapter. A temporary total disability payment under ~~ch. 102~~ those provisions received by an individual for part of a week shall be treated as wages for purposes of eligibility for benefits for partial unemployment under s. 108.05 (3).

SECTION 2. 108.06 (4) (b) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

108.06 (4) (b) (intro.) If an employe receives temporary total disability payments under ch. 102 or the federal longshoreman's and harbor workers' compensation act (33 USC 901 to 950) or a similar federal program unless precluded by federal law, or back pay within the meaning and limits of s. 108.05 (6):

SECTION 3. **Initial applicability.** (1) The treatment of section 108.06 (4) (b) (intro.) of the statutes by this act first applies to determination of base periods for new benefit years which begin during and after the 3rd week commencing after the week in which this act is published.

(2) The treatment of section 108.04 (12) (e) of the statutes by this act first applies to benefits paid for weeks of unemployment beginning with the 3rd week after the week in which this act is published.
