1983 Wisconsin Act 394

AN ACT to create 40.27 (1m) of the statutes, relating to supplementary retirement benefits for certain persons and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 40.27 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

40.27 (1m) ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTAL BENEFITS. Any person who receives an annuity for September 1974 from the Wisconsin retirement system shall be eligible to receive all of the following:

(a) The monthly annuities for which that person was eligible and which that person received for September 1974.

(b) An amount to be paid from the appropriation under s. 20.515 (1) (a), subject to the continuation of that appropriation, equal to 4% times 5 years times either \$200 or the initial monthly annuity, excluding amounts provided from additional deposits, whichever is smaller.

(c) Any supplement for which that person is eligible under s. 41.23, 42.49 (10) or 42.82, 1979 stats., and sub. (1).

SECTION 2. **Cross-reference changes.** In the sections of the statutes listed in Column A, the cross-references shown in Column B are changed to the cross-references shown in Column C:

SECTION 3. **Initial applicability.** This act first applies to annuities paid on the first day of the first month beginning after the effective date of this act.

SECTION 4. **Effective date.** This act takes effect on July 1, 1984.
