**1983 Wisconsin Act 431**

AN ACT to amend 343.09 (1) of the statutes, relating to discontinuing the annual medical report to maintain an operator's license for epileptics who are free of seizures for 10 years following the issuance of the license.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 343.09 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.09 (1) The department may issue a temporary license to any person having epilepsy who has been free of seizures for 6 months prior to application for the license, or such lesser period of time as the secretary may determine is reasonable on the basis of medical evidence submitted by the applicant and who is otherwise qualified to obtain a license, provided the applicant submits to the department a certificate in the form prescribed in sub. (2). Unless sooner revoked, suspended or canceled, such license continues in force as long as the licensee presents to the department 6 months from the date of issuance of such license and at 6-month intervals for 2 years and yearly thereafter on the licensee's birth date until the licensee has been free of seizures for a period of 10 years from the date of issuance of the license a certificate in the form prescribed in sub. (2), except that in no event is such license valid beyond the date of expiration shown on the license. On such date, the license is subject to renewal.
