1983 Wisconsin Act 453

AN ACT to renumber and amend 230.03 (12) (b); to amend 230.03 (12) (intro.) and 230.17 (2); to repeal and recreate 230.03 (12) (a); and to create 230.03 (12) (b) and (c) of the statutes, relating to the definition of "resident" in the state civil service laws.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 230.03 (12) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.03 (12) (intro.) "Resident of this state" means a person who, on the date an application under s. 230.16 (1) is filed, meets at least one of the following requirements:

SECTION 2. 230.03 (12) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 1983 Wisconsin Act 27, is repealed and recreated to read:

230.03 (12) (a) He or she established a residence, as defined in s. 6.10 (1), in this state not less than 10 days earlier;

SECTION 3. 230.03 (12) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 230.03 (12) (d) and amended to read:

230.03 (12) (d) He or she is the spouse of a person meeting the requirements of par. (a), (b) or (c).

SECTION 4. 230.03 (12) (b) and (c) of the statutes are created to read:

230.03 (12) (b) He or she resided in this state for not less than a total of one year out of the immediately preceding 5 years;

(c) He or she is eligible to register to vote in this state; or

SECTION 5. 230.17 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.17 (2) If the administrator refuses to examine an applicant, or after an examination to certify an eligible, as provided in this section, the administrator, if requested by the applicant so rejected within 10 days of the date of receipt of the notice of rejection, shall give the applicant a full and explicit statement of the exact cause of such refusal to examine or to certify. Applicants may appeal to the commission the decision of the administrator to refuse to examine or certify under s. 230.44 (1) (a). Upon request of an applicant or an eligible for a civil service position who has a handicap, the department of health and social services shall obtain from the administrator a detailed description of all duties entailed by such position and shall determine and report its findings to the administrator, as to the ability of the applicant, or eligible, to perform the duties of such position. Such findings shall be conclusive as to the qualifications of any applicant, or eligi-

ble, so examined. A notice of rejection shall notify an applicant or eligible of his or her rights under this subsection.

SECTION 6. **Initial applicability.** The treatment of sections 230.03 (12) and 230.17 (2) of the statutes by this act applies to any application filed under section 230.16 (1) of the statutes or notice sent under section 230.17 (2) of the statutes on or after the effective date of this act.
