- AN ACT to amend 125.07 (1) (title) and (b) (title); and to create 125.07 (1) (a) 3 and 4 of the statutes, relating to the consumption of alcohol beverages by underage persons and providing a penalty.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.07 (1) (title) and (b) (title) of the statutes, as affected by 1983 Wisconsin Act 74, are amended to read:

125.07 (1) (title) Alcohol beverages; restrictions relating to underage persons.

(b) (title) Penalties.

SECTION 2. 125.07 (1) (a) 3 and 4 of the statutes are created to read:

125.07(1) (a) 3. No adult may knowingly permit or fail to take action to prevent the illegal consumption of alcohol beverages by an underage person on premises owned by the person or under the person's control. This subdivision does not apply to alcohol beverages used exclusively as part of a religious service.

4. No adult may intentionally encourage or contribute to a violation of sub. (4) (a) or (b).

SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect on July 1, 1984.
