1983 Wisconsin Act 71

AN ACT *to amend* 230.35 (1) (a) (intro.); and *to create* 230.35 (1p) of the statutes, *relating to* permitting elected officers to take paid vacation and denying them payment for unused vacation time.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 230.35 (1) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.35 (1) (a) (intro.) Except as provided in ~~sub.~~ subs. (1m) and (1p), appointing authorities shall grant to each person in their employ, except limited-term employes, based on accumulated continuous state service, annual leave of absence without loss of pay at the rate of:

SECTION 2. 230.35 (1p) of the statutes is created to read:

230.35 (1p) A state officer elected by the people may take vacation without loss of pay. No such state officer is entitled to payment for unused annual leave.

SECTION 3. **Initial applicability.** The treatment of section 230.35 (1) (a) (intro.) and the creation of section 230.35 (1p) of the statutes by this act apply to any unused annual leave payment request made on or after the effective date of this act.
