1983 Wisconsin Act 75

AN ACT to repeal 20.370 (4) (dd); and to create 20.370 (4) (dd) of the statutes, relating to grants for the replacement of wells and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

SECTION 2. 20.370 (4) (dd) of the statutes is created to read:

20.370 (4) (dd) Environmental aids — municipal well replacement grant program. From the general fund, the amount in the schedule for the municipal well replacement grant program.

SECTION 3. 20.370 (4) (dd) of the statutes, as created by 1983 Wisconsin Act (this act), is repealed.

SECTION 4. Nonstatutory provisions; municipal well replacement grant program. The department of natural resources shall establish a municipal well replacement grant program for the 1983-84 fiscal year. A municipality which seeks to receive a municipal well replacement grant for the purpose of providing a new water supply to replace one or more contaminated wells as required by an order issued under section 144.965 of the statutes shall submit an application to the department of natural resources on or before April 1, 1984. This application shall be in the form and contain the information prescribed by the department. Upon completion by a municipality of all application requirements, the department of natural resources may enter into an agreement to provide a grant for up to 60% of the eligible costs of providing a new water supply to replace one or more contaminated wells as required by an order issued under section 144.965 of the statutes. Eligible costs are limited to engineering design and construction costs.

SECTION 5. Effective dates. (1) Except as provided under subsection (2), this act takes effect on the day following publication.

(2) The repeal of section 20.370 (4) (dd) of the statutes, as created by this act, takes effect on July 1, 1984.
