1985 Wisconsin Act 124

AN ACT to repeal 20.005 (1) (b) (figure); to renumber and amend 341.14 (6); to amend 20.003 (6) and 20.005 (1) (intro.); and to create 341.14 (6) (b) to (d) of the statutes, relating to the maintenance of a certain balance in the transportation fund and registration plates for former prisoners of war.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.003 (6) of the statutes, as created by 1985 Wisconsin Act 29, is amended to read:

20.003 (6) REQUIRED TRANSPORTATION FUND BAL-ANCE. Beginning with the 1985-87 fiscal biennium, no bill directly or indirectly affecting transportation fund revenues under s. 25.40 (1) or expenditures from the transportation fund may be enacted by the legislature if the bill would cause the estimated transportation fund balance on June 30 for the fiscal biennium as projected under s. 20.005 (1) to be an amount equal to less than one percent of the total appropriations from the transportation fund for that fiscal biennium.

SECTION 2. 20.005 (1) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by 1985 Wisconsin Act 29, is amended to read:

20.005 (1) SUMMARY OF ALL FUNDS. (intro.) The budget governing fiscal operations for the state of Wisconsin for all funds from July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1987, is summarized as follows: [See Figures Figure 20.005 (1) (a) and (b) following]

SECTION 3. 20.005 (1) (b) (figure) of the statutes, as affected by 1985 Wisconsin Act 29, is repealed.

SECTION 4. 341.14 (6) of the statutes is renumbered 341.14 (6) (a) and amended to read:

341.14 (6) (a) Upon application to register an automobile or station wagon by any person who was a member of any of the U.S. armed services and who was held as a prisoner of war during any of the con-

flicts described in s. 45.35 (5) (b) to (g) or Grenada or Lebanon under s. 45.34, and upon submission of a statement from the U.S. veterans administration certifying that the person was a prisoner of war during one of the conflicts described in s. 45.35 (5) (b) to (g) or Grenada or Lebanon under s. 45.34, the department shall issue to the person a special plate which is colored red, white and blue and which has the words "ex-prisoner of war" placed on the plate in the manner designated by the department. An additional fee of \$10 shall be charged for the issuance of the plates. Registration plates issued under this subsection shall expire annually on August 31.

SECTION 5. 341.14 (6) (b) to (d) of the statutes are created to read:

- 341.14 (6) (b) A person who maintains no more than one registration under this subsection at one time shall not be charged a fee for registration of the vehicle or issuance of the plates.
- (c) For each additional vehicle, a person who maintains more than one registration under this subsection at one time shall be charged a fee of \$10 for issuance of the plates in addition to the annual registration fee for the vehicle.
- (d) The department shall charge a fee of \$10 for reissuance of any plate under this subsection.

SECTION 6. Effective date. This act takes effect on the first day of the 6th month following publication.
