## 1985 Wisconsin Act 141

AN ACT to amend 342.17 (4) (b) 1. (intro.) and 3; and to create 342.17 (4) (b) 4 of the statutes, relating to the transfer of interests in motor vehicles to a surviving spouse.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 342.17 (4) (b) 1. (intro.) and 3 of the statutes are amended to read:

342.17 (4) (b) 1. (intro.) The department shall transfer the decedent's interest in any vehicle to ~~the~~ his or her surviving spouse upon receipt of the title executed by the surviving spouse and an affidavit by the spouse which shall state:

3. ~~This~~ Except as provided in subd. 4, this paragraph is limited to no more than ~~2~~ 5 vehicles.

SECTION 2. 342.17 (4) (b) 4 of the statutes is created to read:

342.17 (4) (b) 4. The limit in subd. 3 does not apply if the surviving spouse is proceeding under s. 867.03 (1) and the total value of the decedent's solely-owned property in the state, including the vehicles transferred under this paragraph, does not exceed \$5,000.
