1985 Wisconsin Act 164

AN ACT to amend 19.48 (8) and 19.55 (1) of the statutes, relating to the form of notification provided to individuals filing statements of economic interests of inspections of their statements.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 19.48 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:

19.48 (8) Report the identity full name and address of any individual and the full name and address of any person represented by an individual seeking to copy or obtain information from a statement of economic interests in writing to the individual who filed it, as soon as possible.

SECTION 2. 19.55 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

19.55 (1) Except as provided in sub. (2), all records in the possession of the board are open to public

inspection at all reasonable times. The board shall require an individual wishing to examine a statement of economic interests or the list of persons who inspect any statements which are in the board's possession to identify himself or herself provide his or her full name and address, and if the individual is representing another person, the full name and address of the person which he or she represents. Such identification may be provided in writing or in person. The board shall record and retain for at least 3 years information obtained by it pursuant to this subsection. No individual may use a fictitious name or address or fail to identify a principal in making any request for inspection.
