1985 Wisconsin Act 263

AN ACT to amend 948.18 (1) of the statutes, relating to increasing the penalty for certain crimes against animals.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 948.18 (1) of the statutes, as affected by 1985 Wisconsin Act 48, is amended to read:

948.18 Penalties. (1) Any person violating s. 948.02, 948.025, 948.03, 948.04, 948.05, 948.06, 948.07, 948.09, 948.10, 948.11, 948.13, 948.14 or

948.15 (1) is subject to a Class C forfeiture. Any person who intentionally or negligently violates any of those sections is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor. Any person who intentionally violates s. 948.02, resulting in the mutilation, disfigurement or death of an animal, is guilty of a Class E felony.
