

1985 Assembly Bill 520

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1985 Wisconsin Act 88

AN ACT to create 181.56 (5) of the statutes, relating to rescinding dissolution of nonstock corporations dissolved for failure to designate registered agent.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 181.56 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

181.56 (5) The secretary of state shall rescind the dissolution of a corporation involuntarily dissolved under 1983 Wisconsin Act 475, section 7 (2) and issue a certificate stating the rescision if all of the following are met:

(a) The corporation files with the secretary of state 2 affidavits, each executed by a different person who is a principal officer of the corporation, stating that the corporation did not receive actual notice as a result of

the publication of notice under 1983 Wisconsin Act 475, section 7 (2) (a).

(b) The corporation files a designation of registered agent and address in the manner required for changing a registered agent under s. 181.09 (1) and (2).

(c) The corporation adopts, files and records an amendment to its articles of incorporation changing its name to a name available for use in this state, if the secretary of state finds that the name of the corporation seeking rescision of its involuntary dissolution is the same as or deceptively similar to the name of another corporation as prohibited by s. 181.06 (3).
